 - **Forgot your username or password?** Click the “**Forgot your username/password?**” link under the login box and follow the specific instructions for if you are an Ohio attorney or a non-attorney.
 - 4. Once logged in to Judicial eCademy, scroll to the search results window.
 - 5. Select the course you wish to attend and click “**Register online,**” then follow the steps to complete your registration.
 - 6. An email confirmation will be sent after you complete your registration.
