**PLACEMENT** [R.C. 2151.415\(G\)](#)

The child's placement cannot be changed unless:

- the court and the guardian ad litem have received notice of the intended removal;

**AND**

- it is necessary for the protection of the child;

**AND**

- the agency gives the court notice of the reasons why the removal is necessary;

**AND**

- the court approves the change.
